MID-YEAR RECEPTION ENROLMENTS

A reminder that St Joseph's School, Peterborough offers a Term 3 Reception intake each year. The criteria for starting Reception on the first day of school in Term 3, 2024 is that your child will have turned 5 on or before 31 October 2024. If your child turns 5 between 1 November 2024 and 30 April 2025, they will be eligible to start school in Term 1, 2025. If you have a child who is eligible for the mid-year intake, please make a time for a school tour and enrolment interview by contacting our front office.

Our transition program for Term 3 Reception students has commenced providing children with the opportunity to meet and get to know their teacher and peers prior to formally commencing their schooling in Term 3.
