- Ensuring that all staff have completed and maintain their RRHAN-EC qualification
- All staff and volunteers must have a current approved Working with Children Check (WWCC)
- We teach the Keeping Safe Child Protection Curriculum every year to all classes. All teachers are trained in this curriculum area.

TERM 3 PARENT TEACHER DISCUSSIONS

Term 3 Parent Teacher Discussions will occur during Weeks 8, 9 and 10 of this term. We encourage all families to attend these important discussions as we work in partnership to support and promote your child/ren's learning and wellbeing outcomes.

The discussions provide an opportunity for you to meet with your child's teacher to discuss learning achievement and progress, wellbeing, adjustments to learning or any other queries you may have. We encourage you to make a suitable time with your child's teacher either by sending a message via Seesaw or contacting the front office.

ReLAT

The Religious Literacy Assessment Tool (ReLAT) is used annually with Year 4 students in Catholic Education Schools in South Australia. It is designed to focus on knowledge content which is core to the Year 3/4 Crossways Religious Education curriculum. As a basic knowledge test, ReLAT compliments the continuous, fuller, and deeper assessment of learning that occurs in the RE


