At this special Liturgy, we will acknowledge the Year 6 students as they complete Primary school and transition to Secondary year levels. We will also farewell our Year 9 students as they graduate from St Jo's.

Our annual awards will be presented as well as farewells acknowledged.

This year we will again hold our Liturgy outside on the School Basketball Court at **6:00pm**. This Liturgy is a compulsory school event, so <u>all students</u> are expected to be in attendance. We ask students and their families to be at school by 5:50pm ready for formalities to begin at 6:00pm.






